Extension of validity of OPD card for reimbursement of medicines for chronic diseases and validity of chronic disease certificate in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

In reference to this office letter no. 16/229-2PM-2-2020/5750-5942 dated 08.05.2020, letter no. 16/229-2PM-2-2020/15787-15986 dated 17.07.2020, 16/229-2PM-2-2020/28042-28241 dated 22.10.2020, 16/229-2PM-2-2021/407-607 dated 12.01.2021.

I have been directed to invite your kind attention to the subject mentioned above and to state that in view of continued COVID pandemic, it has been decided to further extend the validity of Chronic Disease Certificate and OPD card for reimbursement of medicines for chronic diseases.

The Haryana Govt. employees, pensioners and their dependents, having chronic diseases, may purchase medicines on existing prescription during the period from 22.03.2020 to 30.06.2021. The certificates for chronic diseases, which are due to expire between 22.03.2020 to 30.06.2021, shall also be considered valid till 30.06.2021.

The medical reimbursement bills for chronic diseases for the duration from 22.03.2020 to 30.06.2021 may be reimbursed without renewed prescription on OPD cards.

This relaxation is being made to help State Government employees, pensioners and their dependents in view of extraordinary conditions due to COVID and will not be cited as precedence in future.

These instructions will be applicable from 22.03.2020 to 30.06.2021 and may be downloaded from the Web site of Health Department (<http://haryanahealth.nic.in>).

**Subject:— Extension of Validity of chronic Diseases certificate and OPD card for reimbursement of Medicines for chronic diseases in view of the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19).**

In continuation to this office letter No. 16/229-2PM-2-2020/5750-5942 dated 08.05.2020, letter No. 16/229-2PM-2-2020/15787-15986 dated 17.07.2020 and 16/229-2PM-2-2020/28042-28241 dated: 22.10.2020;

I have been directed to invite your kind attention to the subject mentioned above and to state that in view of the continued Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19), it has been decided to further extend the validity of Chronic Disease Certificate and OPD card for reimbursement of medicines for chronic diseases.

The Haryana Govt. employees, pensioners and their dependents, having chronic diseases, may purchase medicines on existing prescription during the period from 22.03.2020 to 31.03.2021. The certificates for chronic diseases, which are due to expire between 22.03.2020 to 31.03.2021, shall also be considered valid till 31.03.2021.

The medical reimbursement bills for chronic diseases for the duration from 22.03.2020 to 31.03.2021 may be reimbursed without renewed prescription on OPD cards.

This relaxation is being made to help State Government employees, pensioners and their dependents in view of extraordinary conditions due to COVID-19 and will not be cited as precedence in future.
